

EAMS Home and School Meeting Minutes  
November 17, 2009

1. Canteen at tournaments:

- possibility discussed of parents providing a canteen during tournaments at EAMS
- food to be offered would be things like chili and a bun, fresh fruits/veggies, sports drinks
- we could set up eating tables in the mini-gym, put canteen tables across the doors to the music room and have the food and supplies in the hallway by the music room
- there are two tournaments at our school in October, which are over for this year; discussion on canteen for the 2010 year have been postponed to the May meeting

2. Treasurer's report:

- talent night is beginning to be self-supporting; Santa breakfast continues to be our main expense
- canteen would be a potential fund-raiser; not looking at any other fundraising at present

- Mr. Goertzen has done some fundraising and no longer needs funds from the H & S

4. Breakfast with Santa:

- we are again expecting to serve approx. 450 people at the breakfast
- bit of an issue this year over pancake batter as Smitty's batter is no longer available; currently looking into using mix (donated by Carole L.) and supplementing as needed
- Carole L. will take care of the letter to McCains for juice
- Jill A. will check on supplies and order whatever we need
- Brenda N. and Carole L. are looking into the issue of pancake batter
- Kristin Z. is going to look after booking the YQS grill; she will also approach student council about donating the 2-35lb boxes of Christmas oranges as they have previously
- the set-up may need to be done on the breakfast morning as there is a possibility that there is volleyball in the gym on Thurs. evening

- the SSGs, under the guidance of Liz S., will decorate, set tables and also serve from the trolley as per last year; they will also be responsible for running pancakes to the gym from the home-ec lab and the auto-mech area
- Liz S. will also take care of booking Santa
- in the gym, two tables will be set up by the doors with one parent volunteer each to hand out pancakes as students file in
- the largest group will be served first
- Mr. Goertzen will arrange to have choirs sing during the morning
- Annette D. will have her class wrap cutlery and make placemats
- there are 35 volunteer positions to fill during the breakfast (set-up, cooking, clean-up)
