Re: Proof of a Single Dose Vaccination for 12-17 years old for after school athletic activities

Dear Families:

Effective December 6, 2021, as per Public Health orders, all students between the ages of 12-17 must provide proof of at least one dose of either the Pfizer or Moderna Covid-19 vaccination, or, provide a pharmacist confirmed negative test taken within 72 hours of *each* event before they can participate. Physical education classes and intramural programming are exempt from this order.

Students who wish to attend an after school athletic event as a spectator only, must provide proof of the single vaccination with approved photo ID to the hired security at that school, at the time of the event.

Proof of a single dose of the vaccination can include a printout or web view of the individual's government issued immunization record. **Pictures of a QR code are *not* permitted.** An approved photo ID card will also be required (as per the Public Health order), students may use their student card that was issued earlier this year after picture day.

Options:

1. If you wish to show proof of a single dose vaccination to be eligible to participate in after school athletic events, the parent or student can show the principal the government issued print out or web view (via a screen shot) verifying that the student has received at least a single dose. The principal will not keep any records that are shown and will not take in any information other than indicating on a designated and confidential record sheet that that student has met the single dose requirement to participate in any afterschool activity. This will only be done once and will allow the student to participate in future after school events until the Public Health order is rescinded or updated.
2. If you do not wish to have your child show proof of vaccination, then the results of a pharmacist approved and confirmed negative Covid-19 test must be provided to the principal 72 hours before *each* after school event.
3. You may choose not to have your child participate in the event/activity. The following link can direct you to the health order:
