
Treaty I Land Recognition

Rationale for Catchment Area Revisions


- Currently the Crescentview School catchment area is the largest catchment area in the division.
- The catchment area for ÉCVS/ÉAMS was larger as a result of changes that took place in 2007 when Victoria School and Prince Charles School were closed.
- For the 2023-2024 school year Crescentview School will exceed its student capacity.
- We have applied for modular classrooms for École Crescentview
 School and ÉcoleArthur Meighen and have been told that we must fully utilize all available classroom space in all schools across the division before modular classrooms are considered.

Student Placement September 2023 for Current ECVS Grades Kindergarten, 1, 2, and 3 Students

- ★ Current students at École Crescentview School in grades K, 1, 2 and 3 will attend their new catchment area school.
- ★ Transportation will be provided to the new catchment area school for the students that attended École Crescentview School.
- ★ The new school will become the student's designated school and the student will remain at that school.
- ★ Families will receive a letter informing them of the student's new school.
- ★ Families will have the opportunity over the next four weeks to see the new school and meet the staff at the new school.










Student Placement September 2023 EAMS Current Grades 4, 5, 6, and 7 Students * Current students at École Arthur Meighen School in grades 4,5,6

- ★ Current students at Ecole Arthur Meighen School in grades 4,5,6 and 7 will either attend their new catchment area school or have the opportunity to be granted, "School of Choice" and attend Crescentview School.
- ★ Transportation <u>will not be provided</u> to, "School of Choice", Crescentview School.
- ★ Transportation will be provided to the new catchment area school for the students.
- ★ A letter will be sent home to inform the family of the new school and a School of Choice application for those families wishing to remain at Crescentview School.
- ★ For families choosing to attend the new catchment school, that school will become the student's designated school.
- ★ School of Choice applications must be completed and submitted by May 30, 2023.

- ★ Students that are in the Crescentview School Catchment Area
 - Pick-up and drop-off will be 6th SE off of Queen Ave (Regency House)
 - O SE Corner of Duke Ave (in front of the Federal Courthouse/Former Women's Gaol) North Side
- ★ YQS/FLR Students South of Saskatchewan Ave to 8th Street SW
 - Dufferin Ave (PCI)
- ★ YQS/FLR Students North of Saskatchewan Avenue from Tupper Street to 8 Street NW
 - O Dufferin Ave (PCI)
- ★ Southport pick-up locations will remain the same
- ★ LVS/NMS Students North of Saskatchewan Ave to Royal Road North
 - O 7th Street NE (7-11 Playground)
 - Alfred Ave facing East (Firehall)
 - Victoria Ave facing West (Armories)
