We are writing to provide a further update about the cybersecurity incident that PowerSchool, our student information system (SIS) provider, recently experienced.

In our previous updates about the PowerSchool cybersecurity incident, we mentioned that PowerSchool would be sending emails to students, parents/guardians, and educators whose information was involved in the incident it previously experienced. We are aware that PowerSchool has now begun sending out notices to students and parents/guardians. You may shortly receive this notice, or you may have already received it.
